What is Bullying?

Bullying is a deliberate, hurtful, physical, verbal or emotional behavior towards another person.

Such acts could include:

- calling names
- teasing
- spreading rumors
- saying or writing nasty things about another student
- making fun of another student
- threatening others with physical abuse or physical harm
- making another student feel scared
- taking or damaging another student's things
- hitting, kicking, pushing or shoving
- making someone do something they don't want to do
- using inappropriate language- "kill, cap you, shoot, die, cut, slash" to threaten others
with direct or insinuated physical harm
